FEAR

Psalms 3 (p. 415)

What is the command given most often in the Bible? Contrary to popular opinion, it is not the command to **love each other**. Rather it is the command to **“not be afraid.”** That should tell us something about life in a broken world—it can be scary. Fear is the natural response to danger, and we are surrounded by things that are potentially dangerous. But although fear is natural, it can also be dangerous in itself. It can discourage us, disorient us, distract us and even defeat us. So what do we do with our fear? King David shows us in Psalm 3 that, like other emotions, it should be processed in the presence of God.
